School Summary

The current Rotolo Middle School opened in 1993. This facility was originally named Batavia Middle School. Several years after its opening, the name was changed to Rotolo Middle School in honor of Sam Rotolo, who served as principal of Batavia's only middle school for 23 years. RMS is dedicated to leading all students to their maximum potential: academically, socially, emotionally, and physically. The middle school has been named a School to Watch® five times by the National Forum to Accelerate Middle-Grades Reform for its academic excellence, responsiveness to the unique challenges of early adolescence, and equity in providing every student with high-quality teachers, resources, and supports. RMS serves students in grades six through eight and is the only middle school in the District.

Academics and Student Support

Core Content Areas: Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Physical Education, and Health

Innovative & Enrichment Programs: Art, Music, Communications, Drama, Spanish, French, STEM, Project Lead the Way, Culinary Arts, Woodworking, Production Technology, PE Leadership Program

Student Support: Offer multiple programs to support English learners, students with disabilities, and gifted and at-risk learners. Student services staff includes 3 counselors, 12 special education teachers, 1 social worker, and 2 psychologists.

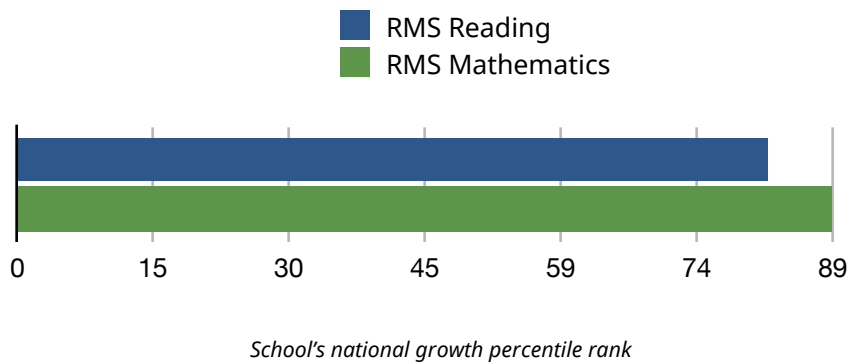

NWEA MAP Test Scores

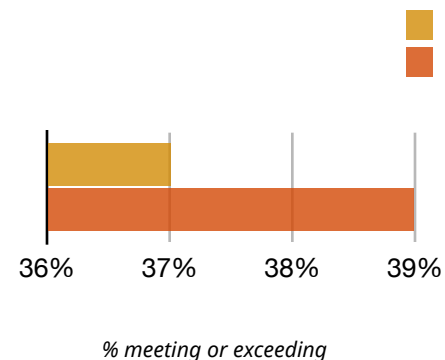
Rotolo Middle School assesses all students in fall, winter, and spring with the NWEA MAP test in the areas of reading and mathematics. Based on 2017-18 national data, RMS students outgrew students nationwide by 82 percent in reading and 89 percent in math.



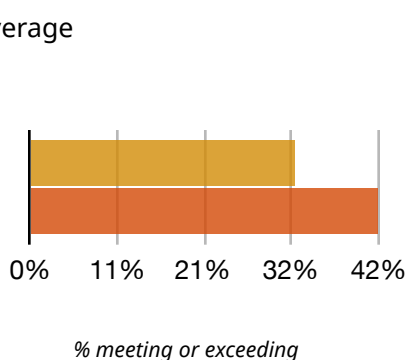
PARCC Results Meeting and Exceeding
